MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room this month, say, "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up and do big things! Who helps you do big things?" Say with child: "God helps me do big things!"



DRIVE TIME

As you drive, tell your child to look out of the window for big and little things. Encourage [him/her] to name the big and little things [he/she] sees. Maybe it's a big truck or a little bird. Talk about how God made us to do big things and He will always help us.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle with your child and take turns thanking God for helping you do big things today. Say, "Dear God, [child's name] and I want to thank You for helping us do big things today, like (name one thing) and (your child names one thing) and (name one thing) and (your child names one thing) ..." Continue naming things and close by saying, "We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



BATH TIME
