



HOW DOES IT MAKE YOU FEEL WHEN YOU'RE OVERLOOKED?

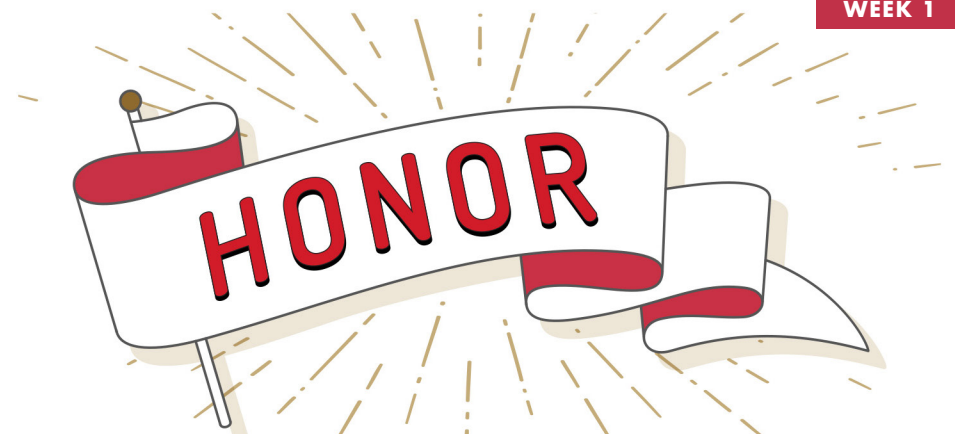
DAY 5
