





Has Science disproven God's Existence?


- There are no published experiments disproving the existence of God.
- Scientific Method: Disproves based on conflict with evidence.
- Is God possible according to science?




Can a Scientist be a Christian?

- Science developed as a branch of Christian theology.
- Many scientists believe in God or a higher power.











Can a scientist believe in something without proof?

- Many scientists believe in things without proof.
- Most theories started out as ideas that had no evidence to support them.
- Belief in alien life?



What about the Burden of Proof?

- All claims require evidence to support them
- Default position is "We don't know"
- Any claim without proof is based on faith
- Can it be falsified?



Is the Existence of God Plausible?

- Quantum theory predicts the existence of parallel universes and alternate dimensions.
- Big Bang theory
- Fine tuning and hardwiring for religious belief




Doesn't the Bible Conflict with Science?

- Do all Christian leaders see a conflict between science and faith?




The conflict between science and faith

- Atheists and creationists teach science and faith are incompatible.
- Both sides condemn the other.
- Do we really need to choose?
